ASHFoundation Graduate Student Scholarship for Minority Students

Note: *These 2015 guidelines are available to serve as a reference for future applicants. Application guidelines and submission instructions are updated each year. The new guidelines will be available in early 2016.*

Supports minority Master's or doctoral students in communication sciences and disorders programs who demonstrate academic achievement and promise. Applicant must be a member of an ethnic or racial minority group and a full-time Master's or Doctoral student. Either research or clinical doctorates are acceptable. Open to U.S. citizens only. Part of the ASHFoundation's Graduate Student Scholarship competition. Apply here:

New Century Scholars Doctoral Scholarships

These \$10,000 scholarships support strong doctoral candidates who will commit to attaining the research doctoral degree and to working in a higher education academic community in the field of communication sciences and disorders in the United States.

*Students must be accepted to, or currently enrolled in, a research doctoral program (PhD or equivalent) in communication sciences and disorders. Clinical doctoral students are not eligible to apply for this program; however, clinical doctorate students are eligible for other ASHFoundation funding programs. Students completing their doctoral program prior to **June 2016 are not eligible for the November 2015 funding cycle.***

Graduate Student Scholarships

Full-time master's or doctoral students in communication sciences and disorders programs demonstrating outstanding academic achievement are eligible to compete for \$5,000 scholarships. Supported in part by [Psi Iota Xi](#) National Philanthropic Organization and the Marni Reisberg Memorial Fund.

Student with a Disability Scholarship

Full-time graduate students with a disability who are enrolled in a communication sciences and disorders program and demonstrate outstanding academic achievement are eligible to compete for a \$5,000 scholarship. Supported by the [Leslie Londer Fund](#).

Minority Student Scholarship

Racial/ethnic minority students who are U.S. citizens and who are accepted for graduate study in

audiology or speech-language pathology are eligible to compete for a \$5,000 scholarship. Supported by the [ASHFoundation's Minority Scholarship Fund](#).

International Student Scholarship

Full-time international/minority graduate students studying communication sciences and disorders in the United States and demonstrating outstanding academic achievement are eligible to compete for a \$5,000 scholarship. Supported by the [Kala Singh Memorial Fund](#).

Scholarship for NSSLHA Member

Undergraduate seniors, with an active national NSSLHA membership, who will begin graduate study in the fall of the competition year are eligible to compete for a \$5,000 scholarship. Supported by the [ASHFoundation's NSSLHA Scholarship Fund](#).

COMMUNICATIVE DISORDERS SCHOLARSHIP

*DEADLINES All scholarship applications and requested materials must be received at Sertoma headquarters by 4:00 pm Central Time on **March 30th** of each year. Faxes are not accepted.*

Sertoma's annual Communicative Disorders Scholarship Program, funded by the Sertoma Annual Fund, is for graduate students pursuing advanced degrees in audiology or speech-language pathology from institutions in the U.S. These scholarships, worth \$1,000 each, are awarded in the spring to help offset the cost of tuition, books and fees incurred during the following school year. Sertoma's Communicative Disorders Scholarships Program provides more funds nationally for graduate level study in communicative disorders than any other single organization.
